

CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT HACKS

1. USING ATTENTION GRABBERS

Attention Grabbers, as the name suggests grabs the attention of the students back to the teacher. They are usually something that the students can relate to easily and are prepared according to the age.

Examples:

1, 2.. Eyes on you..

One class.. One vision..

We are.. IEEE..

2. STUDENT ROLES

Allocating different roles for the students during the period of teaching the lesson will be helpful to improve the student involvement.

Example:

While doing the group activity, every person can be allocated a role, like, time keeper, one person who looks into the details, one person who looks into the context, etc.

3. TEACHER ACTIONS

Moving around the classroom and using gesture with hands & facial expressions add a lot of interest to the lessons that the students are learning. The teacher strictly has to avoid standing at a static place.

Example:

When students are answering a question, the teacher can consciously move to the other side of the room, so that students speak loud enough.

4. REWARDS

Giving away tokens or goodies to the proactively engaged students will also encourage the other students to do the same.

Example:

The teacher can ask a lot of questions, during the lesson, and the student who answers right can be provided with a token or a goodie.
